The Klondike Derby is a two-day competition (Saturday and Sunday) between patrols of Boy Scout Troops and Venture Crews. Webelos Dens competition is one day (Saturday) only.

Webelos Dens are invited to campout over night at this event. Webelos Dens must come prepared with the appropriate camping equipment for this cold weather event.

Girl Scout Troops from the Southern Pines Council - GSA are also invited to participate in this competition and camp over night.

Troops may enter as many patrols as it desires. A patrol may have a minimum of 5 scouts and a maximum of 8 scouts. Only one Eagle Scout or two Life Scouts may be assigned to each patrol.

The patrols are self sufficient for the entire event. All the food, gear and other equipment that the patrol may need will be transported with them, either carried or placed on their sleds.

The patrols proceed from station to station. Each station is named after an Alaskan city. At each station they are tested on a different skill learned in Scouting.

The patrols receive a score from the 'Mayor' of the station. The scores range from 0 to 10, zero being the lowest and ten being the high score. Scores will reflect how well the patrol performs the activity and their Scout Spirit and cooperation among themselves and other patrols.

Troop Leaders do not accompany the patrols from station to station. Troop Leaders may work at a station as 'Mayor' or take the weekend off and relax in camp.

All cooking by the patrols will be done in an area supervised by an adult.

Patrols and Dens may arrive at EGG HARBOR CITY LAKE on Friday night 01/8/2010 to camp out or on Saturday morning. STATIONS WILL OPEN AT 09:30 AM ON SATURDAY.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Klondike Derby is to test Scouting Skills in a competition between other patrols and also test the Scouts abilities to work together in a patrol setting as well as the Scouts ability to demonstrate Scout Spirit in the midst of competition.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Each patrol must have a sled to carry their camping supplies throughout the course outlined on the map supplied by the Klondike Governors.
2. Patrols shall have at least 5 Scouts and no more than 8 Scouts per sled. There is a limit of 1 Eagle Scout per sled and 2 Life Scouts per sled.
3. Each patrol must start the course with a fully equipped sled and end the course with a fully equipped sled. Points will be deducted from the patrol score if they abandon their sled along the course or if equipment is missing from the sled at the sled inspection station.
4. Each patrol must start at the station they are assigned at the beginning of the event. The patrol must then go to the next station as it is listed on the map provided by the Klondike Governors. The direction of travel between stations will be indicated on the map.
5. If a patrol is completing a station as another patrol arrives at the station, the arriving patrol must wait until the initial patrol completes the station. (Unless directed otherwise by the station 'Mayor').
6. NO STATIONS will be completed out of the order that they are listed on the map provided by the Klondike Governors. Points will be deducted for not completing the stations in the order given. If you need to move past a station ask permission from the Station master first. Some sleds will be going in reverse order on the course.
